



## Cartogram Maps Game: Check Your Knowledge of the Geographic Distribution of the Various Orthodox Churches in the USA!


The map below is a normal map of the USA. All states on this map are shown proportionately to their actual geographic size. But the eight maps of America on the following two pages are different: each of them reflects geographic distribution of the members of some particular Orthodox Church jurisdiction. On each map, each state is re-sized proportionately to the number of members of this particular jurisdiction living in this state. For example – just as an example – if twice as many GOA members would be living in Vermont than in Texas, than on this GOA map the size of Vermont would be twice larger than Texas. Your goal is to find out which map represents one of the following eight Orthodox Church jurisdictions: Greek Orthodox Archdiocese, Antiochian Orthodox Archdiocese, Orthodox Church in America, Carpatho-Russian Dioces, Ukrainian Orthodox Church of the USA, Serbian Orthodox Dioceses, Russian Orthodox Church Outside of Russia, Romanian Orthodox Archdiocese.
