## Maps: Geographic Concentration of Adherents of Ten Eastern and Oriental Orthodox Churches

The following ten maps show the counties (colored in red) with the greatest number of adherents for ten Eastern and Oriental Orthodox Churches. For each Orthodox Church, the red-colored counties - when added together - account for $50 \%$ (half) of all this Church's adherents. As an example, the map on the next page is the map for the American Carpatho-Russian Diocese (ACROD). In 2020, ACROD had parishes in 57 U.S. counties. If we would rank these 57 counties by the number of ACROD adherents, the top 9 counties (colored in red) accumulate $50 \%$ (half) of all ACROD members. The other $50 \%$ (half) ACROD adherents attend parishes situated in remaining 47 counties which are colored in blue color. The maps are available for:
